Member Scholarship Competition Information

For Other Than Accredited Colleges of Forestry



The **NEW** Scholarship option is offered to children of active regular or cooperative members who are high school seniors or current college students. This scholarship is for students who intend to pursue an education in business, attend a trade school or a community college. If the student attends a trade school or community college the scholarship is \$750. If attending a 4 year business college, the scholarship is \$1,500. Both options come with an opportunity to renew the scholarship for additional years. The field of study must be related to a career in the logging industry.

Each Candidate Must Submit:

- The AOL Scholarship Application Form
- An original essay, not to exceed three pages, covering the **essay topic: “What challenges do you see in the field of logging and what are your views on meeting these challenges?”**
- High school transcripts
- SAT or ACT scores
- Field of Study

Candidate will be selected on the basis of the following criteria:

- Candidate’s studies and experiences as they relate to chosen field of interest.
- Scholastic performance in all classes as it relates to success in higher education (GPA).
- SAT or ACT scores.
- Thought process, grammatical usage and capability to express self in the essay.
- Legibility, neatness and accuracy of information submitted.

The **potential contribution** of the student to the logging industry is the important issue. Financial need of the student is NOT a criterion for selection. The selection of the winner will be made by the AOL Scholarship Committee, which are members of the association. All committee decisions are final.
